In addition, a review published in 1999 by the Institute of Electrical and Electronics 12 Engineers (IEEE) found that IV and V had a measurable beneficial effect on a programs development. For example, it promoted the earlier detection of system faults, identified a greater number of faults, helped to reduce the average time it takes to fix faults, and enhanced operational correctness. The study concluded that any process that systematically applies well-designed IV and V activities to a structured software development process would result in similar benefits. Typically, IV and V is performed by an agent that is independent of the development organization to obtain unbiased reviews of a systems processes, products, and results, with the goal of verifying and validating that these meet stated requirements, standards, and user needs.
